

## Woodburn Sidewalk Improvements

Sidewalk improvements will be made to provide citizens improved access to the downtown, Woodburn Community Park, and other nearby amenities. Sidewalk improvements will occur along Park Street, Center Street, Bull Rapids Road and Main Street. Sidewalk improvements will consist of 5-foot wide concrete walks.

The Park Street sidewalk project is located along both the east side and west side of Park Street, between Main Street and Front Road (0.23 miles). The proposed improvements include the following:

- Removal of existing concrete sidewalk.
- Construct new concrete sidewalk.
- Reconstruct existing concrete drive approaches.
- Construct new curb and gutter on both sides of drive approaches.
- Construct new concrete alley approach
- Patch the existing asphalt pavement around approaches

The Center Street sidewalk project is located along both the east side and west side of Center Street, between Main Street and Front Road (0.24 miles). The proposed improvements include the following:

- Construct new concrete sidewalk and new concrete drives.
- Construct new curb and gutter on both sides of drive approaches.
- Patch the existing asphalt pavement around approaches.
- Construct new 6" concrete curb along sidewalk.

The Bull Rapids Road curb walk project is located along both the east side and west side of Bull Rapids Road, between Main Street and Front Road (0.13 miles). The proposed improvements include the following:

- Removal of existing concrete curb walk.
- Construct new concrete new curb walk.
- Reconstruct existing concrete drive approaches.
- Patch the existing asphalt pavement along approaches and curb walk.

The Main Street sidewalk project is located along the south side of the road between Becker Street and Carl Street (425-feet). The proposed improvements include the following:

- Removal of existing concrete sidewalk.
- Construct new concrete sidewalk, and new curb & gutter.
- Reconstruct existing concrete drive approaches.
- Decorative Street Lighting (6 lights along Main Street)
- Patch the existing asphalt pavement around approaches

### Impact:

- Improvement of the existing sidewalk system in connection to various amenities throughout Woodburn while also providing new sidewalks to ensure safe access routes.

### Readiness:

- Local match funding to cover project development costs and 20% construction costs committed by City of Woodburn resolution.
- Preliminary engineering completed.
- Red flag survey conducted. No major environmental issues identified.
- No permits identified as needed.
- No acquisition anticipated, within the public right-of-way.

**Budget:** \$591,069.50
